

The Urantia Book, a purported revelatory text, was first published in 1955 in Chicago. Over one million copies of this tome of 2,097 pages have been distributed in more than 20 languages. Almost a third of the text, Part IV, claims to provide an authoritative new version of the life and teachings of Jesus that builds on the New Testament accounts. Three "fellowship" organizations have now arisen, each populated by many educated professionals. This paper reflects upon the conflicting responses to a rare claim of epoch-making revelation.

It argues that each major response clusters around one of the classic three levels of interpretation first identified by Origen of Alexandria, who distinguished the literal, moral, and spiritual dimensions of scriptural texts. The new religious movement growing around the Urantia teaching has distinctive, idiosyncratic, and sometimes baffling characteristics requiring more scrutiny by researchers and scholars.
